I like to work intuitively, so I usually just start cutting and sewing hoping that something good will happen and it usually does."

Fun with 4 & 9 Patch / Fri, Oct 9 /

4 and 9 patches are basic building blocks to quilt making, but take them beyond basic by slicing them apart, mixing and matching the pieces and inserting new fabrics. It's a process filled with serendipity.

Bring lots of fat quarters and other fabrics. This technique works well with modern or traditional fabrics. When in doubt, pack more fabric to expand your options.

Free Cut Piecing / Sat, Oct 10 /

Stack up pieces of fabric, slash then arrange the pieces and sew them back together into units that can be combined into traditional, pictorial, or abstract designs with curves (or not). Think of this as drawing with your rotary cutter, but you don't have to know how to draw. In class, we'll make a leaf wall hanging/table runner and some other samples to master the technique.

Bring 6 coordinating fat quarters for the leafy wall hanging, four fabrics cut 12 & 1/2 inch square for big quarter circle blocks, other fabric pieces at least 6 & 1/2 inches square for heart blocks. Solids will show off your piecing, but prints can be used as well. Bring lots of fabric to expand your option.
