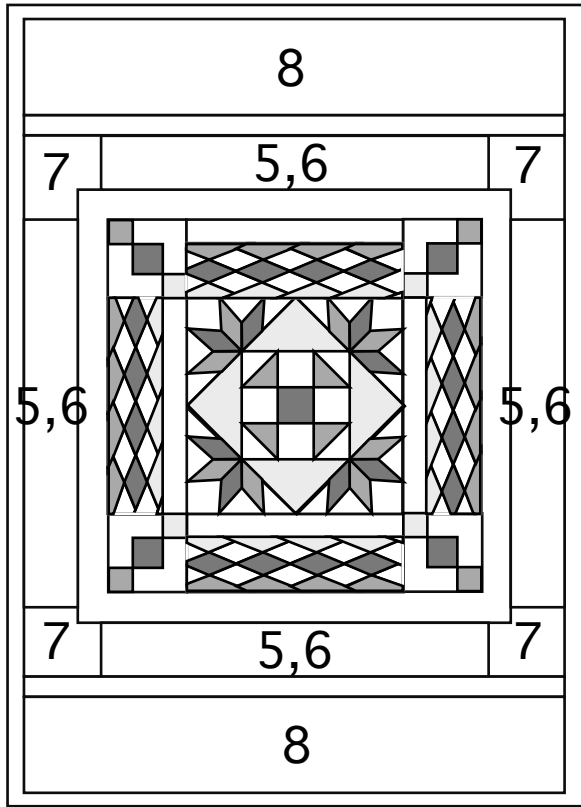




GLHQ BOM #4

Seminole Piecing



Cut **two** strips from the full width of each of your fabrics as follows:

 4.75"

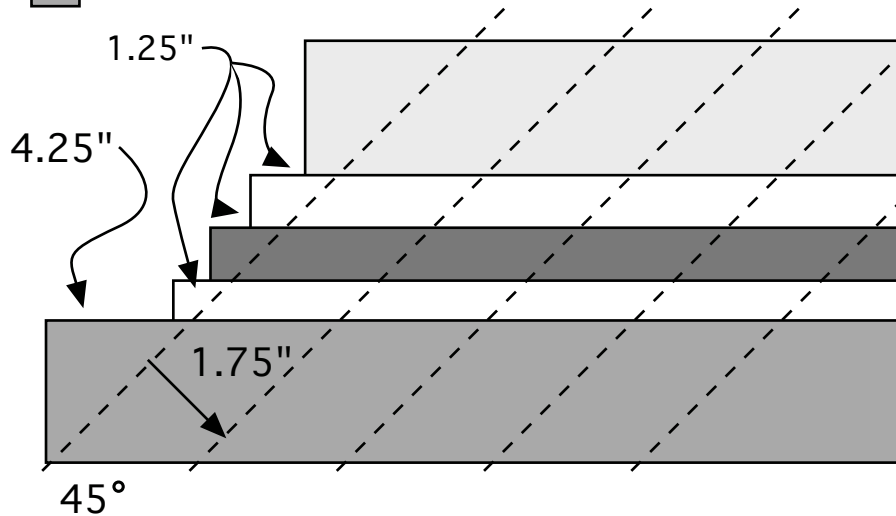

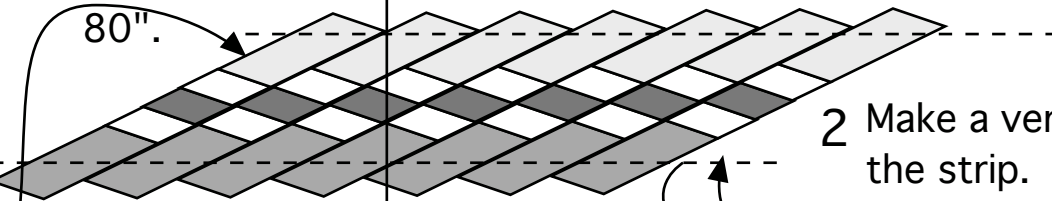
Make 2 strip sets, sewing them together as shown below, staggering them for most efficient use of fabric.

Cut the strip set on a 45° angle, 1.75" sections.



1 Arrange strips as below and sew all of them together into one long strip. About

80".



2 Make a vertical, straight cut through the strip.

3 Take this edge and match it up with the other edge and sew together.

4 Trim strip to a height of 5", centering pattern.

5 Cut this strip into 4, 18.5" X 5" pieces. Cut 4 strips of background fabric, 2.75' X 18.5". Sew to Seminole strips on the edge that will be on the inside. Strips should measure 7.25" X 18.5". Assemble with blocks 1, 2 and 3, as in above schematic.
