Quilt Show Entry Guidelines and Procedures:

1. The Quilt Show entry is open to GLHQ members only.
2. All entry forms, payment, and photos must be received by **May 1, 2023**. Each entry must have its own form. There is a \$5 fee per entry. One color photo showing the entire quilt must be submitted per entry.
3. GLHQ reserves the right to refuse entries that do not meet requirements.
4. Items must be clean, in good condition, made of fabric, contain 3 layers and must be quilted.
5. Quilts larger than 45" wide must have a 4" hanging sleeve (casing) stitched to the top of the quilt back. Smaller quilts (less than 45" wide) will be attached with pins and do not require a hanging sleeve.
6. Photography is allowed during the show

How to make a hanging sleeve:

Cut a strip of fabric 9 inches by the width of your quilt minus 1½ inches. Turn each short end under ¼ inch twice and machine stitch. Sew the long edges together with a ¼ inch seam, Press the seam open. Center the sleeve at the top of the quilt back with the seam toward the quilt and one fold barely touching the sewn edge of the binding. Hand stitch the top and bottom long edges and under layer of the ends, making sure the top layer is open to accommodate a hanging rod.

Quilt Show Waiver and Assumption of Loss:

Your entry may already be protected by your homeowner's or business insurance policy. The insurance policy that covers GLHQ is a personal liability policy only. It does not provide any protection against property damage, loss or theft. We will handle the entries with great care and will watch guests to prevent the public from handling them. In addition, security guards are present during the show. Nevertheless, we cannot accept financial responsibility for anything that may happen to the property of the entrants. Therefore, we ask all entrants to sign the following statement to evidence their recognition and assumption of risk and return it with the entry form.

By signing the agreement, as part of the entry form, I expressly agree to release Great Lakes Heritage Quilters and Mercy High School, and their respective agents, employees and members from all liability for any loss, damage, theft, injury, destruction to any article entered by me in the GLHQ Quilt Show in Farmington Hills, Michigan. I understand and assume that I bear the risk of all uninsured loss to my property and that it is up to me to properly insure my own property against any or all risks.
