

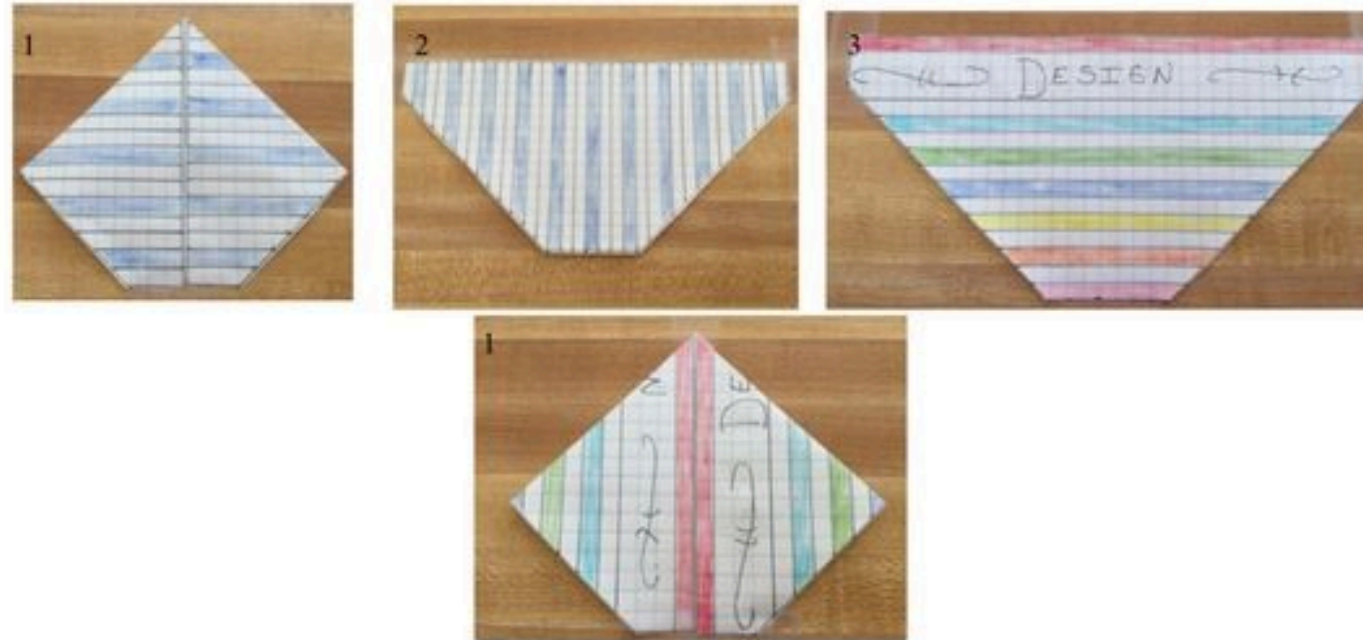
# Quilted Shawl Instructions

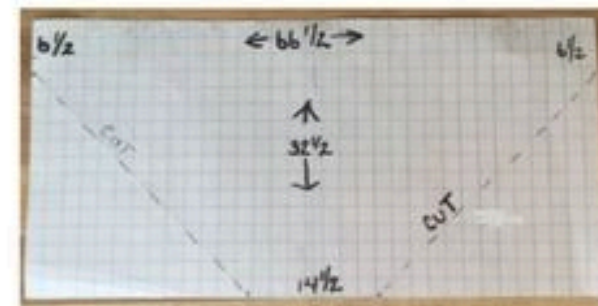
## Planning:

- (1) Consider what the matching ends look like when folded around.
- (2) For this design you will need one strip  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $66\frac{1}{2}$ " and 13 strips  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x  $66\frac{1}{2}$  \* always use  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowance.

## Trimming:

**IMPORTANT** your finished measurements are no larger than the following



Use the excess in scrappy projects.

## Backing:

You will need 2yds of polar fleece. This will provide backing and pockets for two shawls. (\*\* this product should not be ironed directly) – cut off a 12 inch strip on the end to use for pockets (this is to be cut in half). Cut the remaining piece in half as shown:
